
## **BOOK WEEK**

#### Class News

#### Year 3 - 6

**English** – Investigating the relationships between and among **texts**, exploring similarities and differences and explaining and justifying responses to texts to widen personal preferences.

Maths - Exploring Chance and Conducting Probability Experiments. Students will continue to build the language associated with chance. They will use everyday situations, as well as classroom experiments, to discuss likelihood. Students will arrange situations along a continuum from "impossible" to "certain" to indicate the likelihood of each event. Stage 3 will use numerical values (fractions & percentages) on a continuum, building the link to using fractions as a way to describe the likelihood of outcomes.

Science – "Package it Better" a unit of work on Natural and Processed Materials. We will be capturing student interest and finding out what they know about packages and materials used to make them. The design process will be further developed.


