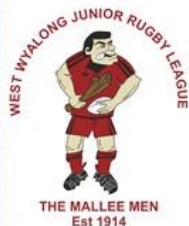

If you are turning 12-17 yrs anytime in 2017 your **BNSW rego cost is \$60**

If you have 3 or more children participating, we will discount your fees by \$10 per player.
