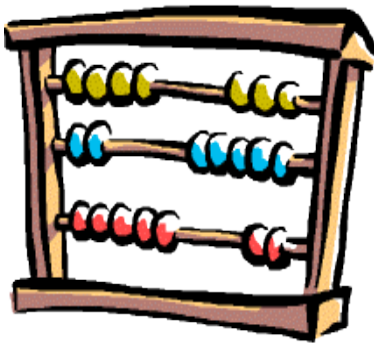
This week's news topic : **Something special about you.**

Using place value to count, order and read two and three digit numbers.

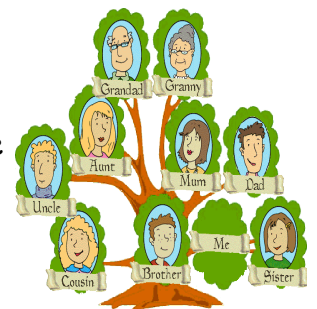
Year 2

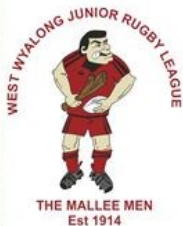
