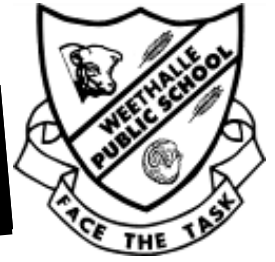

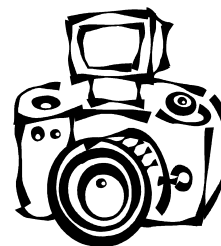

Lachlan Expedition

20 April 1817 to 29 August 1817

On 21 June 1817, John Oxley wrote in his diary:

"The farther we proceed northwesterly, the more convinced I am that, for all practical purposes of civilized man, the interior of this country westward of a certain meridian is uninhabitable, deprived as it is of, wood, water, and grass."

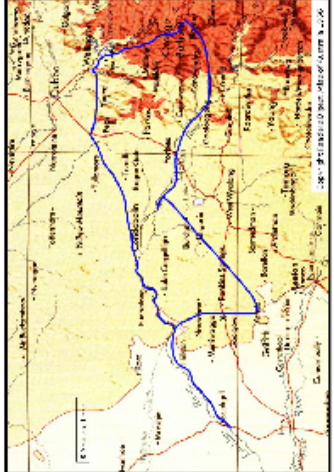
