activities they will be involved in.


This week marks the official dates for the Children's Book Council of Australia Awards. This years theme is: Reading is My Secret Power. To celebrate, this Friday,

Time: 10:30am to 12:30ish pm. Class will start at 10:30am – if late, you will have to catch up so please don't be late!


