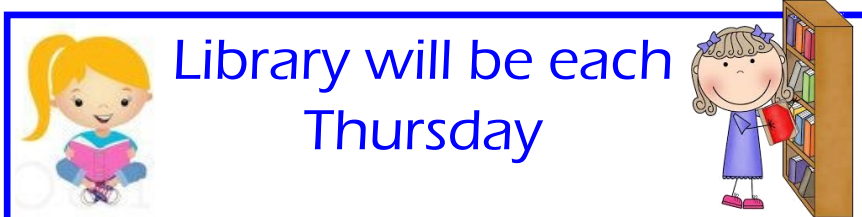
FROM THE PRINCIPAL
